(No DTDO decal required)

Please follow these instructions and those of the site attendants. Some disposal restrictions are noted.

Please take the time to separate and prepare these materials as directed and place them into the recycling containers. Thank you!

**Commingled
(All in one Container)**

**Plastics/Aluminum
beverage cans/Steel
cans: # 1 and # 2**



Bottles and jugs including soda, milk, juice, water, detergent, shampoo, etc. Look for number 1 or 2 on the bottom of the container. Preparation: remove lids, rinse, and flatten. No tubs, wide mouth jars, plates, cups, Styrofoam, motor oil bottles or plastic bags.

Aluminum Beverage Cans

Drink cans only. Crushing is optional



Steel Cans

Rinse, label may stay.
(Food cans only)



Mixed paper:


Newspaper, office paper, mail, paperboard (shoeboxes, cereal boxes), magazines, catalogs, phone books, paper bags.

Preparation: place in paper bags and put into paper bin or tie with string.

No plastic bags, paper contaminated with food or dirt, wet paper, pizza boxes.



Cardboard: corrugated cardboard only. Preparation: keep dry, remove packing materials and flatten. No waxed, dirty, wet, or pizza boxes.



Glass: green, clear, and brown bottles and jars, mirrors (w/o Frame), crystal, ovenware, and non-fluorescent light bulbs.

Preparation: rinse, and remove lids from bottles. No need to sort colors or remove cap from light bulbs. **Think safety when disposing of glass. Do not break. Safety glasses and gloves recommended.**



Antifreeze: Do not mix any other materials with antifreeze. Maximum 5 gallons per visit.

Used motor oil: including transmission & power steering fluid, diesel fuel, hydraulic fluid, lubricating fluid, kerosene and fuel oil. From residential sources only. Don't forget to bring your oil filter! Maximum 5 gallons per visit. No mixtures of motor oil and water, solvents, gasoline, paint products, flammable liquids, brake fluid or any other hazardous materials.



Used cooking oil: No need to filter the oil before recycling. Cooking oil containers can be recycled.

Waste Gasoline: and 2-cycle gas from residential sources only. Maximum 5 gallons per visit. Do not place in oil tank. Please see attendant for assistance.



Electronics: All electronic devices, computer monitors, and televisions.



Oyster Shells: Place in yellow trashcans.

Batteries: Lead-acid automotive, marine, mower, other vehicle batteries and rechargeable batteries.



No single use alkaline batteries.



Small Propane Tanks: Small tanks typically used with outdoor grills. No large household heating tanks. **Please call the gas company listed on the tank for large tanks.**



Scrap metals and white goods: stoves, washers, water heaters, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, metal pipe, metal siding, tools, lawn mowers, etc. Do not crush appliances that contain Freon. Remove gas tank from motors and drain crankcase. Cut one end out of barrels. No crab pots, wire, wire fencing, tanks or sealed canisters.

Curbside Collections: Christmas trees are collected in January. Yard debris and white goods are collected bi-yearly as part of the Bulky Waste collections.

Dry Trash Drop Off Center

(DTDO decal required)

The following special materials are accepted only from Kill Devil Hills' residents at the Public Services Dry Trash Drop Off Center (Next to the Recycle Center) with restrictions as noted.

You must obtain a Town sticker or a Temporary Permit from the Public Services Department to dispose of these items. (You will need to show proof of residency at time of issuance) Contact **252-480-4080** for more information.

Yard waste: leaves, limbs, and brush:

Preparation: remove debris from plastic bags. Limbs: no longer than 6 feet, tree trunks: no larger than 12 inches X 14 inches.



No Commercially generated yard waste, lot clearings or stumps. These must be taken to the Dare County C & D Landfill.

Bulky items and construction & demolition debris:

Mattresses, box springs, furniture, lumber, siding, junk, glass, shingles, carpet, etc.

Mattresses / box springs: 3 of each per day.

Pallets: 3 per day.

Shingles: 1 pickup truck load per day.

Concrete/Asphalt/Brick: 1 wheelbarrow load.

No commercially generated C & D or bulky waste items. These must be taken to the Dare County C & D landfill.

The Dare County C & D Landfill is located at 1603 Cub Road, Manns Harbor, NC Ph: (252) 473-2059



Tires: Tires must be off the rim. (Rims may be placed with scrap metal) From residential sources only. Maximum 4 tires per day.

The following items are not accepted in the DTDO area.

No asbestos, hazardous materials, liquid waste, paint, trailers or vehicles of any kind.



Household Hazardous Waste and Pesticide collections are periodically conducted by State agencies in conjunction with the Town & County.
