Engineering and design plans for the proposed 2016-2017 Street, Drainage, and Right-Of-Way Improvements Project have been completed and plans are available for review at the Town of Kill Devil Hills Public Services Department.

The Town has solicited construction bids for this work and those bids were presented to the Board of Commissioners at their November 14, 2016 meeting. At this meeting, the Board approved implementation of the 2016-2017 Street, Drainage, and Right-Of-Way Improvements Project by RPC Contracting, Inc. in the following areas:

2016-2017 Street, Drainage, and Right-Of-Way Improvements Project:

- Improvements will include **paving and drainage** (street work) in the following locations:
 - **W. Clark Street**
 - **Mustian Street**
 - **W. Carlton Avenue**
 - **Anchor Court**
 - **Schooner Court**
 - **Cooke Place**

- Improvements will include **water main replacement** and associated work in the following locations:
 - **W. Clark Street** (Fox Street to S. Croatan Hwy.)
 - **Blue Jay Street R-O-W** (Airstrip to Scott Street R-O-W)

We anticipate the start of construction on about November 28, 2016.

According to tax records, your property is adjacent to one of the project construction areas. If so, please remove all private property items that you wish to retain from the Town right-of-way area by the start of the construction date listed above. It is possible that privately owned materials that are not removed could be damaged or destroyed by the contractor in the course of his work. This includes the following: fencing, landscaping materials or plantings, gravel or stone parking areas. **There are two exceptions to this requirement: (1) your mailbox, which the contractor will be responsible for maintaining and (2) replacement of town-approved driveways by the contractor.**

Please be aware that some portions of the project have been designed to manage stormwater runoff within the Town-owned right-of-way areas. Because of the associated requirements for drainage areas, private property items cannot be placed or replaced in the Town's right-of-way after the project is completed.
