ICO was able to help 970 families last fiscal year giving back over \$500,000 in monetary outreach with the following: Car Insurance, Car Payments, New Tires, Car Repairs, Donated Car, Budget Counseling, Cell Phone Minutes, Mental Health Counseling, Physician fees, Prescriptions, Dental, Mortgage, Rent, Lot Rent, Security Deposits, Housing Assistance, Gas Vouchers, Veteran Outreach & Cancer Outreach, (including medical transportation and monthly living expenses), Electric and Water Bills, Bus Tickets (to where they have support), Home Rehab, Ramps, Roofing, Water Heaters, Plumbing, Childcare, Cremations, & Referrals to other agencies.





→ Our Programs

- **Temporary Emergency Outreach:** Assistance with rent, mortgage, transportation (bus, car repairs, gas vouchers, auto insurance), utilities, medical needs (prescriptions, dental, physician services, surgeries), childcare, and referrals to other agencies.
- **Cancer Outreach:** Up to \$5,000 in direct support for residents with cancer, plus medical transportation reimbursement for cancer-related trips.
- **Veteran Outreach:** Help with medical needs, home repairs, transportation, navigating VA services, and obtaining DD214 forms.
- **Home Rehab Outreach:** Home modifications such as ramps, bathroom repairs, and other critical home improvements to ensure safe living conditions.
- **Disaster Outreach:** Partnering with Dare County and the Outer Banks Community Foundation to provide case management and direct support for individuals affected by disasters.
- **Mental Health Outreach :** Sound Minds Program: Access to mental health support and counseling services.
